Enumeration

One of the few surviving records from the early years of the District of Maple Ridge is a notebook with the results of an enumeration of the people of Maple Ridge. It lists the names of the main residents and counts spouses, children, sons and daughters, lodgers, employees and soldiers. It shows the number of horses, cattle, hogs, goats, poultry and bees on the premises. It tells us whether the main residents were freeholders, tenants, or homesteaders. And it also lists the Japanese, Chinese or "Hindoo" residents. Residents of the "Indian Reserves" were not counted. This survey is a great resource for historians.

The record shows that at the time the survey was done, the total population of Maple Ridge was 2210 individuals. However, there is an error in the document, and after correction (see page 5) the total comes down to 2120. The information collected was arranged by township and Hammond and (Port) Haney were enumerated separately.

The notebook does not show when the census was held, but it is obvious that it was done during the First World War. The record shows that 137 men had left Maple Ridge to serve King and country. By then around half a dozen had already lost their lives in the Great War. John Arnold Pope, the son of Chief Constable Edmund Pope, Maple Ridge's first policeman, was dead when the survey was done. He died in November 1916. The next soldier from Maple Ridge to die would be Robert Fletcher of Whonnock, who was killed in August of 1917. He was overseas but still alive when the census was held. Therefore the time of the survey is framed by these two dates—after November 1916 and before August 1917.

The following pages show transcripts of the pages of the notebook and copies of the pages of the original. Incorrect spelling of names in the original pages and poor legibility may have resulted in occasional inaccuracies in names in the transcripts.

Around the time of this census, the District tried to attract more investment and residents, as is reflected in a story "Seventy-two square miles of Prosperity" in *The British Columbian* of 2 January 1917 under the names of N. S. Lougheed, Reeve, and D. C. Webber, Clerk, Port Haney. A transcript of the text of the article, painting a rosy picture of Maple Ridge, is included on pages 98 and 99.

Seventy-two square miles of prosperity

The British Columbian 2 January 1917

Maple Ridge Section of the Weekly British Columbian — N.S. Lougheed, Reeve; D.C. Webber, Clerk, Port Haney

Maple Ridge, lying on the north bank of the Fraser River about midway from the sea and the mountains contains 72 square miles of property and opportunity. Prosperity for the 300 people living in the municipality and opportunity for three times that number to be just as prosperous. Of this approximately 40,000 acres of land in the municipality, 10,000 are cleared and under cultivation. 10,000 are partially cleared and in occupancy, and there is about 10,000 acres of light clearing which can, with little cost, be brought under the plow. The balance of the district, the northern portion, is rough and timbered, and only in places is it arable and suitable for fruit culture.

Maple Ridge is essentially a district of small farms and fruit ranches. There are a couple of hundred small holdings of from five to twenty acres devoted to fruit, berries and poultry, and all the owners are making more than a comfortable living—they are making money.

War years and depression has not hurt

Maple Ridge is unique in these years of war in that the conflict has not seriously affected its prosperity. Its farms have been cultivated profitable; its fruit has been picked and marketed at a remunerative figure. Its lumber mills have operated steadily. Its greenhouses have turned their thousands of dollars worth of produce into the markets of Coast cities; its logging camps have never shut down; its payroll, larger than any other rural municipality in the Fraser Valley, has never been reduced; its material prosperity has been great; its only sorrow is in its 300 sons away on the business of the king and country, many of them to remain.

Fruits, milk, potatoes worth a million

Fruit, dairying, root crops, and poultry and greenhouse products aggregate more than \$1,000,000 annually, and are constantly increasing. Fruit is the principal crop, followed by dairying. Berries alone cover more than 500 acres of small farms and there are as many more acres devoted to larger fruits, and many cars are dispatched yearly to Calgary and Northwest prairie points, while Vancouver, but fifty miles away, is within an hour and a half of Maple Ridge shippers, who ship direct in smaller quantities.

Dairying is an important branch of agriculture in Maple Ridge, and Vancouver takes daily all the cream and whole milk that can be delivered to the various shipping stations. Roots yield amazingly and potatoes are produced on the higher lands that rival those of Ashcroft and find a ready market at top prices.

Hugh greenhouses succeed

Every condition is just right in Maple Ridge for the production of greenhouse stuff, and there are four large greenhouses in the district supplying Vancouver and New Westminster with hothouse products and with flowers. One greenhouse alone, that of Brown Bros. At Port Haney, has ten acres under glass devoted almost entirely to growing flowers for Vancouver. Three other smaller greenhouses are in successful operation.

Clay products of district large

Of big modern brickyards there are four with an output of 400,000 daily. Two are now operating almost exclusively on partition tiling for the Coast cities, though building bricks and agricultural drain tile form an important part of their output. Clay deposits are immense, sufficient to supply brick and tile to build a thousand cities. This industry is capable of great expansion which is looked for with a renaissance of building in Vancouver and other Coast cities.

Logging and milling brings wealth

Maple Ridge is one of the most important districts in the Fraser Valley from a logging and lumbering standpoint. There are in the district three shingle mills with a combined output of 250.000,000 shigles yearly. There are three sawmills with an aggregated output of 25,000,000 feet of lumber annually, and the Abernethy & Lougheed logging concern each year cut 40,000,000 feet of logs which are exported or worked up in the local mills. The combined pay roll of logging camps and mills reaches \$500,000 per year and there is still a billion and a half of timber within the municipality or adjacent to its boundaries and within the sphere of local operations, enough to keep the mills running for sixty years. There is six miles of logging railway in the municipality which brings logs to mill and river and this will be extended as occasion requires.

Haunt of hunters and of game

Maple Ridge is the haunt of hunters and myriads of water fowl in season, the sloughs, ponds, small lakes and streams being favoured feeding grounds for duck and brant on their pilgrimage from the Artic southward in the autumn and early winter. Pheasant shooting is good in season and the native grouse, deer and bear are to be found in the wilder and more rugged country just to the north and east of the district.

Trout fishing is excellent, three of the finest trout streams in British Columbia flowing through the municipality—the Lillooet and North Lillooet river and Kanake [sic] creek. Commercial fishing for salmon is an important business on the Fraser in the season [for] several hundred fisher[men] along the waterfront of Maple Ridge, their catch being collected daily by boats from the canneries downstream.

Water supply secured for all time

Maple Ridge has secured water rights on the North Lillooet [Alouette] river for the future of the district, the stream lending itself rapidly to this purpose; a small sum, comparatively, only being necessary to dam the river and divert the water at a height that will allow for gravity distribution to every farm and home in Maple Ridge. To protect the supply for all time to come, 10,000 acres at the head waters of this stream have been placed in reserve by the Dominion Government and can never be logged or occupied.

Schools and churches excellent

The district is well supplied with schools, there being nine with seventeen teachers employed. There is a similar number of churches, all the leading denominations being represented. There are telephones serving the whole district, while electric light and power can be had in every home and on every farm. The generating plant of the Western Canada Power Company is but a couple of miles from the eastern boundary of Maple Ridge on the Lillooet [sic!] River where thousands of horse-power is generated. There are in the municipality 120 miles of good roads, all well macadamized or gravelled, and tributary roads touching every small farm and residence in the township. There are seven post offices in Maple Ridge, and the district is well served by this number.

Maple Ridge an old municipality

Port is the seat of local government, and is the most important centre of the municipality. Hammond and Whonnock being other towns of considerable size. All these centres are well supplied with water, light, phone, and power. The taxes are low, considering the improvements made by the council—school tax and general purposes taxes aggregating but 12 mills on the dollar. Maple Ridge was the second rural municipality to organize in British Columbia, and its municipal government dates back to 1874, when a poll was taken and W.H. Harris was elected warden. Langley, just across the river, was the first municipality to organize, antedating the Maple Ridge organization by one year.

One important factor in the prosperous development of Maple Ridge has been the United Farmers, a co-operative organization of about 250 farmers, with warehouses and elevators at Hammond, Whonnock, and Port Haney. This organization buys for its members in quantity, flour, feeds, grains—crushing and grinding the latter—fertilizer, lime, implements, etc.

The management is very conservative and careful, and business is done on a margin of 3 percent and a cash basis. This has permitted the union to save many thousands of dollars to its members, and still pay a dividend of 8 percent on this capital stock. All stock is held by the members of the association. Maple Ridge has an excellent agricultural society and its annual exhibitions are features of the valley farming year. It has an agricultural hall and grounds at Port Haney, and the organization has had much to do with the development of the district in past years.

Inducement to settlers

Probably no portion of the Fraser Valley offers the inducements to settlers, especially on small farms, that are offered by Maple Ridge. Here unimproved land can be purchased that is suitable for fruit, berries, dairying or general farming with very light clearing at prices ranging from \$30 top \$100 per acre; close to school and church, on good roads, and within miles of a shipping station. Probably [at] no place in the valley can a man make good on so small capital as here, though he should have sufficient money to purchase and clear his place, at least partially, and be able to live until his canes come into bearing. However, there are scores of men in the community who arrived with little or less, who purchased their places on long terms, built as they could and worked for wages in mill or camp or brickyard and gradually improved and built up their places, and now are making a comfortable living on their small farms and look forward to competence.

Land prices are not unreasonable

Improved farms come as high as any place in the valley, depending upon improvements, bearing orchards, bearing berryfield and stocked and improved dairy farms bring high prices, and capital is required to purchase these. Such lands range in price from \$150 to \$400 per acre, and are money makers. The man with little or no capital can come here and can do as well or better than elsewhere, for work is plentiful and wages are good. The berryfields insure work for some weeks for every member of the family.

Industrial advantages offered

Maple Ridge has twelve miles of water frontage with forty feet of water from any point on the southern border to the sea, and large lumber carriers come up the river and load at the mill's dock at Hammond and Port Haney. As the mouth of the river is dredged out and the channel made permanent, development of the water frontage will take place from the sea up. As this occurs, Maple Ridge can offer every inducement and advantage that can be secured for very low prices and on any kind of terms. Water is plentiful and rates are low. Light and power are no cheaper anywhere in the province than here, and there is ever advantage of transportation that any portion of the Fraser Valley enjoys.
